







Post-Surgical Cataract Instructions

Provided below is a list of instructions patients should adhere to following cataract surgery in order to ensure optimal recovery:

- 1. Carefully follow the doctor's instructions.
- 2. Use the prescribed eye drops 6 times a day and make sure you wash your hands first.
- Have your protective eyewear (will be provided) or sunglasses on at all times.
- 4. Don't rub or rinse your eyes.
- 5. Keep away from smoke, dust, and pets.
- 6. Keep physical activity to a minimum and do not handle any heavy objects during the first few days post-surgery.
- Activities such as watching television and reading are allowed.
- 8. Should any complications arise (such as pain, redness, low vision, etc.), speak to your doctor immediately.
- The exposure to or inhalation of any scent/perfume won't have any negative effect on your recovery.
- 10. Kneeling and prostration during the first month is not recommended.
- 11. Driving is not advised during the first week due to blurry vision.
- 12. Avoid playing with children and other activities that may result in bumping or bruising.
- 13. Avoid straining yourself while coughing, sneezing, and passing stool (especially when constipated).
