The Interventional Radiology & Pain Management Department diagnoses & treats patients suffering from acute & chronic pain conditions using the latest minimally invasive interventional techniques. Services include:

- Treatment of spine-related pain & sciatica
- Treatment of neck & shoulder pain
- Treatment of arthritis
- Treatment of sports injuries
- Treatment of entrapment neuropathies
- Treatment of cancer-related pain
- Treatment of post-surgical pain
- Treatment of cervicogenic migraine headaches
- Nucleoplasty
- Kyphoplasty/vertebroplasty
- Treatment of back & joint pains with radiofrequency waves

The department also provides minimally invasive diagnostic and therapeutic treatment options for a selection of diseases, most notably:

- Image guided biopsies
- Drainage of collections in the abdomen and its organs
- Treatment of Uterine fibroids via embolization
- Treatment of Varicoceles via embolization.
- Insertion and exchange of gastrostostomy feeding tubes
- Angiography, balloon angioplasty, stenting and coiling
