







Post-Intravitreal Injection Instructions

- 1. It is completely normal and painless to sense some pressure or discomfort in the eye area while being injected.
- 2. You may experience minor bleeding in the white part of your eye, which will disappear within 1-2 weeks.
- 3. It is common to see eye floaters (spots in your vision). They will reduce over time.
- 4. Avoid rubbing your eyes during the first few days post-injection.
- 5. Use your eye drops as prescribed.
- Should you experience any sudden complications (pain, redness, discomfort, sensitivity to light, or low vision), speak to your doctor immediately.
- 7. Make sure to schedule your follow-up appointments as per your doctor's instructions.
